Subject: Condor Linears with OVP

Question: What is the difference between models with OV and OVP in the part number?

Answer: Nothing. They are the same units.

Explanation: Many years ago when Condor switched over to a new computer MRP system, the model number was limited to only so many characters. Some of our linears with OVP in the model number exceeded the limit for number of characters.

Example: HAA5-1.5/OVP-A+ has 15 characters. Abbreviating it to HAA5-1.5-OV-A+ made it only 14 characters thereby allowing it to fit into the MRP system. This abbreviation method was then done on all linear models with OVP for commonality.

HAA5-1.5-OV-A+ is what we call the Order Number. All our internal Sales documentation and advertising uses the Order Number.

HAA5-1.5/OVP-A+ is the actual Model Number. It is the model number shown on the power supply silkscreen label and is also the model the safety agencies (UL, CSA & TUV, Demko) use on our safety certificates.
